You're invited on a bus trip to Chenoa Manorwhere animals with nowhere left to turn call this welcoming farm...home.

Chenoa is a unique local **animal protection sanctuary** who's mission is to provide a safe haven for animals and promote a more humane world through educational programs and events focused on children and teens through the age of 18.

Meet some of the more than 200 wonderful animals who live at Chenoa Manor – thoroughbred horses, rabbits, pot-bellied pigs, chickens, roosters, cows, sheep, pygmy

pot-bellied pigs, chickens, roosters, cows, sheep, pygmy goats, Jersey steers, and more. You'll also meet Nevis, a border collie who helps with the care of the animals.

Most of Chenoa's residents were left with nowhere to turn – some suffered the abuses of factory farming, others from cruel and unnecessary lab experiments, some simply were abandoned in the wild and left to fend for themselves. All of these animals are permanent residents of Chenoa Manor and are provided a lifetime of care, safety, compassion and love.

Chenoa is staffed solely by volunteers, including the Executive Director, Dr. Rob Teti, a licensed veterinarian, who founded Chenoa Manor in 2003 and sees to the animals' daily needs and care. Dr. Teti, and the staff at Chenoa believe if kids can develop a relationship with animals based on mutual trust, patience and understanding, then those same qualities will be carried over to relationships throughout their lives. Dr. Teti will be providing a **personal tour** and workshops for Buzzy's bus passengers.

This trip is open to everyone – adults & children. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Bus leaves from Buzzy's at 10am and returns to Buzzy's at approximately 3pm

A Day at Chenoa, including bus transportation, is \$10/person.
